SCIENCE CLUB - ACTIVITY





The science club organized an experiment on acids, bases, and salts, allowing students to observe their chemical reactions. Acids are substances have a sour taste and turn blue litmus paper red. Common examples include vinegar (acetic acid) and lemon juice (citric acid). Bases are substances feel slippery, have a bitter taste, and turn red litmus paper blue. Common bases include baking soda (sodium bicarbonate) and soap.
