Fun classroom activities involve fingerprinting in Grade 1. Children adore learning about the science of fingerprint identification, or dactyloscopy.

The students will remain happy by cataloguing their own prints, examining others, and even working on imaginative art projects. A fingerprint is a trace that is left behind when an object is touched by the ridges on the fingers, hands, toes, or feet. Students create a collection of direct fingerprints using distinct methods in this project, where they also discover their own friction ridge patterns.
